1. **Calcutta Love Presbyterian Church:** By the grace of God from 29<sup>th</sup> June in the morning Bengali Sunday service at 8:30AM begun with 21 church attendants and also the second Bengali service as usually at 11 AM in the midst 10:00-10:45 have adult Bible study. Sunday English service is going on 2:30 P.M. in this mother Church. We had several special guests to speak on Sundays and perform their ministry during this period.

10<sup>th</sup> August(Sun) Rev. Kim Sang Jung Pastor of Keysan Presbyterian church delivered the message.

This day also from Kolkata Gideon International visited our church and Mr. Sanjay Kumar Shared about Gideon ministry, a collection of Rs.5000 was given to Gideons. Also a scholarship of grant of Rs.4000 was given to Partha Halder a doctoral student on Chemistry and Soumen.
