# India Reformed Presbyterian Theological Seminary:

Seminary's IRPT 3rd Examination was held from 20th ~ 24th April. 1st term on 7th-11th September and 2nd term on 14th-18th December. We are grateful to our teachers Rev. Dipendu Pramanick, Rabindranath Roy, Rev. Subhas Sardar, Rev. Swapan Kr. Mondaland and visiting professors Rev. Willem Smouter, Jan Mudde, Willem Scheffer from Netherland and Dr. Kim Ha Jin, Rev. Kim Jong Kuk, Rev. Jung Hyung Bum from Korea and Dr. Yeo Yun Sae from USA who taught different subjects this year.

### Bengali E. E. Clinic:

From 13th April to 18th April, the 40th Bengali EE Clinic was held at Kolkata Love Presbyterian Church where 15 clinicians successfully completed the clinic where they aided 121 persons, preached the gospel to 91 people, out of which 45 received Christ as their Savior. We are grateful to the International & Indian EE for supporting the clinic materials.

#### Summer Out-reach:

This year, just after the ending of our seminary term, we could not send our summer out-reach team because the Loksava (Central Govt.) Election was held from the 26th April to 13th May in West Bengal and other North-East states.

Therefore, instead, from 14th May to 6th June our 21st summer out-reach team (Joshua – Hill team, Caleb – Plain land, Paul – Boat) reached a different place and returned back safely. We have sold our Swaraz Mazda Minibus for US \$3000. Please pray for the rest of the money (US\$13000) so that we might be able to buy a minibus which may cost Rs.7 lacks (US\$16000) for the outreach and social activities.



## Visiting USA & Netherlands:

During this summer vacation Sukrit, Sang-Yee and Barnabas were able to go to USA to reunite with the rest of their children. And during this time Sukrit was able to share the Word of God and Mission Report at Sung Eun Presbyterian church (NC), Redeemer Presbyterian Church (VA), Berean Baptist Church (VA), and Victory Presbyterian Church (LA). We are evergrateful to them who loved, cared and prayed for us in USA, and may God bless them all.

Sukrit's 50th Birthday was celebrated in USA and attended by the Sung Eun Church members and many other friends; it was unforgettable! We left USA on 5th June and via Frankfurt we arrived in Amsterdam with our whole family on 6th June and received a grand welcome by the Netherlands Reformed Church members.

We have visited so many places in Netherlands that we feel it was our home coming. Although we had a family time which was arranged by Rev. Willem Smouter, in the middle of that Sukrit & Sang-Yee also had the opportunity to share the Word of God & Mission report to Netherland Reformed Church (Breukelen), NRC (Enerde), NRC (Apeldoorn). After a wonderful time in foreign-land we returned to our country on 26th June.

#### Mother's Sickness:

After returning to India, Sukrit & Sang-Yee had to go to hospital immediately because Sukrit's mother was sick and hospitalized. By God's grace she recovered and returned home on 9th June, and in month of October Sukrit's sister visited mother and she start eating her food by tube. Please pray for her quick recovery. Also, on 10th June, Sang-Yee received a telephone call from her sister (Soon Yee) that her mother fell down and broke her right shoulder bone. Praise God that her mother's operation was ok. Please pray for her quick recovery as well.

### AILA Cyclone:

On 25th May, in the Sunderban Islands there was AILA Cyclone which was a great disaster.

We were not aware of the intensity of it, but after returning, Sukrit went there with a CMA medical team on the Eternal life Boat from 6th ~ 7th July and witnessed the disaster with his own eye and shared it with Sang-Yee and the church members.



We all prayed together to supply some rice (because the salty water damaged the rice fields, leading to no cultivation), mosquito nets (lot of mosquitoes), bed-sheets and for rebuilding believer's houses (which has been broken).

Therefore Sang-Yee shared about AILA cyclone and the needs to different churches and Christian friends while she was taking care of her mother in Korea.

Thank God that different churches, individual Christians, Missions and companies from Korea stood with us to help the AILA victims. We are grateful to the following teams who came to share the love of God by supplying people's needs as well as by sharing the good news.
