OUR LORD IS GOOD ALL THE TIME

It is my joy to write to you that our Lord is good, all the time!

By the providence of God we celebrated our 25th Anniversary of Christ Mission Ashram from the 29th of February to the 4th of March 2012 with distinguished guests and dignitaries from India and other countries. We are thankful and grateful to all our prayer partners, mentors, advisors, board members and supporters for the past 25 years and even before that.

The 25th Anniversary was celebrated with all 1200 guests, together with our church believers, for five days.

We also held a Thanks giving service on the 29th of February in the evening and on March 1st our India Reformed Presbyterian Theological Seminary 24th Graduation Service was held.

There were 9 B.Th. and 4 M.Div. students who graduated, five people were ordained as pastors, 4 people as elders and seven as deacons.

The participants came from all CMA churches from KLPC, West Bengal, Jharkhand, Odessa, Assam, Sikkim, Meghalaya, Tripura and even from Nepal.

On the 5th and 6th of March the delegates from other states & countries were taken to Sunderban Island for a Mission trip with our SALT & LIGHT boat. It was a wonderful time for them.



In the month of April we held the final examination for IRPTS and 43 Bengali Evangelism Explosion III Clinics were held at Kolkata Love Church.

One hundred thirty-four people were contacted, 78 people heard the Gospel and 69 people accepted the Lord as their personal Lord and Savior.

Easter Sunday at KLPC five believers were baptized and a communion service took place after the service. We had a wonderful love feast.



The 24th Summer Outreach Ministry went from the 29th of April to the 30th of May, where a total of 16 members participated, including three pastors (Rev. Haripada Bera, Ranjit Halder, Sukrit & Sang Yee Roy), seminary students and church believers.

This year the Tempo-Traveller gospel van worked in different districts in West Bengal (Nadia, Murshidabad, Maldah, Dakshin Dinajpur, Uttar Dinajpur, Darjeeling, Jalpaiguri etc) and states like Assam where we met Bishop S.P. Raju (Kokrajhar, Bijni, Borpetta, Gauhati) and Meghalaya, Shillong.

Within this one month the Lord helped us to worship with 17 different people groups and to worship together in their languages (such as Bagdi, Bairagi, Sannashi, Rajbongshi, Robidas, Nepali, Santali, Boro, Rabaha, Assamese, Khasi, Garo, etc.).

One month into our outreach we experienced the presence of the Lord with us and power of the Holy Spirit working among different people groups.

We learned that 23 years before when we first did our Summer outreach, even driving five to seven hours, we could not find a church, therefore we had to spend the night in the Gospel van or empty Market Verandah.

But now, after 2-4 hours of driving, we find churches and believers who are waiting to receive us. Praise the Lord because He is alive and still working among us.

We have a special need for the completion of the Kolkata Mission Centre. We were promised help by a particular mission body with almost fifty percent of the project.

Since they have failed to keep their promise, our KMC work is now stopped after building the third floor.

To build the fourth and fifth floor within one and half years we need US \$150,000- please pray for it. If we pay one floor at a time we will need US \$50,000 per floor.



After returning back from a one month Summer outreach, Sukrit and Sang Yee went to UP, Barabanki by Jammu Dawai Express and had a Sunday Worship with Evangelist Shymal Nasker and Chandra Sekher.

They went to Gorakhpur with Chandrasekher to visit Munnah who has come back from Korea after knowing the Lord where he was working for nine years through Rev. David Yoon.

Later Munna's father & family members came to know the Lord. Thank God that He helped Sukrit & Sang Yee bear the heat (47C) and made a successful foundational work over there.

Please pray for Evangelist Chandrasekhar & Shymal Nasker that they may be used mightily to carry the task in Barabanki and Gorakhpur in UP.

And, that in coming days, many more unreached villages in the district might be reached with the Eternal Gospel (Revelation 14:6). This was the place where the BABRI MOSQUE was demolished.



Also, pray for the Good Samaritan Hospitals remaining work : connection of electrical wiring job to be done soon and painting.

We need all Hospital accessories such as 50 beds (each bed cost US \$300), 2 operation theaters, 3 dental chairs, Pathological instruments, Radiology machines, and the staffs, doctors and nurses.





After returning back from UP we were busy re-opening the IRPT Seminary on the 2nd of June 2012 and teaching in the Seminary with other teachers.

At our seminary Campus, due to a heavy storm, a tall tree fell on one corner of our Prayer House and broke the roof. We are repairing the roof which might cost us US \$1500.

Please pray that we might be able to complete it before the "Four Days Fasting Prayer" during the DURGA IDOL worshipping festival time and also have the finances to complete it. Also, please pray for the repair work of the "Eternal Life & "Salt & Light" Boats.



We are also grateful to the Netherland Reformed Church for their generosity, who offered for us to go to Bangkok to spend one week as a vacation. It was a second honeymoon for celebrating our 25th Wedding Anniversary.

God has been so good to us that while spending six weeks in Korea, the believers of Shin Banpo Church allowed us to stay in their homes while they were on vacation in Bangkok, Indonesia or the USA.

SABBATICAL LEAVE:

Sukrit and Sang Yee are on a Sabbatical leave after serving 25 years. Please pray for Sukrit as he had gone through a medical checkup for his high blood pressure at SNUH in Korea.

We were praying for a car and the gracious Lord has provided us a used car by Elder Lee Ok Jin from Richmond.

We are believing that in our remaining days all our needs will be met by His people just as the Lord provided for Elijah through crows.

Please pray that in the absence of Sukrit & Sang Yee those who are in responsibility positions in India might be empowered by the power of God to accomplish the task.
